

- 1. A special folder is available in the unit to assist you in complying with Strata Building Rules.
- 2. Arrival times would be appreciated between 2.00pm to 5.00pm on the scheduled day of arrival. Special consideration will be given to carers travelling from the country areas.
- 3. Car parking is available in Bay 35 on the right of the entrance parking area.
- 4. Basic items include eg linen, towels etc
- 5. Smoking is not permitted inside the unit. Smoking is permitted on the balcony, however the external unit doors must be closed.
- 6.Telephone can be used for local calls only. Guests are asked to pay for their calls by putting 40c into the box provided. No STD calls available.
- 7. Wheelchair access can be difficult, unless wheelchair is collapsible.
- 8. Guests are asked to leave the Retreat ready for the next guests to move in i.e. all linen and towels are to be washed and hung out to dry, and the unit left tidy.
- 9. On departure (by 11.00am), key is to be placed in Unit 35's letterbox on the lower ground floor foyer.
- 10. No responsibility is accepted by the Carers Association of WA for any damage or injury sustained by any person residing in the unit.

# Staying at the retreat

The Carers Retreat is a two bedroom, full furnished air conditioned apartment in South Perth, set in peaceful surroundings with beautiful views scanning Perth City and the Swan River. Miss Anne Bluntish is pleased to offer the Retreat for the use of Carers in need of a low cost, restful, hassle free short break in a comfortable relaxing environment.

Anne's own experience and her involvement with the community inspired her to provide assistance to Carers. After much work and many hours of research, the 'Carers Retreat was formed in June 1994.

# Who is eligible to use the retreat?

The Retreat is reserved for the use of Primary Carers who are providing 24 hour, around the clock care for a family member or friend who is living under the same roof with them. It is not available for paid care workers.

Under certain circumstances permission maybe given for the care recipient to accompany the carer. Consideration will be given to access the Retreat for temporary low cost self contained accommodation, while accompanying care recipient receiving treatment at hospital or special health services. Decisions will be made in consultation with members of the Retreat committee and only, if the Retreat is not being used for the purpose of respite.

## Costs?

A fee of \$15 per night, per person is charged to assist with operational costs of the unit, eg electricity, rates, water etc. Subsidised respite by an organisation, will incur a cost of \$25.00 per carer, per night.


# How long can I stay?

A carer can access the Retreat up to a total of 14 nights per year. The maximum stay is 7 nights at one time with the minimum being 2 nights. Special Occasions and times will be considered Retreat bookings are managed by Carers Association of Western Australia.
