

Karrinyup Shopping Centre Redevelopment



The Karrinyup Shopping Centre is set for a major redevelopment with a development application lodged with the Stirling Council in March. If approved, the work is planned to start in late 2016 and will take up to three years to complete at an estimated cost of around \$600m.

The centre will have approximately 290 stores on completion.

The redevelopment is expected to boost the Western Australian economy and retail sector. It is estimated to generate 2,500 jobs during construction and create 2,500 new retail, support and management positions.

Karrinyup Shopping Centre will be mixed use, including retail, residential and commercial.

The redevelopment of this iconic Perth shopping centre aims to enhance the retail, leisure, food & beverage and entertainment experience of this area. The design will connect with nature through high ceilings, water, and natural timber – it has a uniquely coastal flavour that is elegant, sophisticated yet warm.




